Product Description: Mycobacterium tuberculosis (M. tuberculosis), transposon mutant 2620 was created by disruption of a probable alanine rich hydrolase (MT2835, Rv2765), of the wild-type strain CDC1551. M. tuberculosis, strain CDC1551 is a clinical isolate that exhibited high levels of infectivity and virulence during a tuberculosis outbreak that occurred in rural Kentucky and Tennessee from 1994 to 1996.
