**Product Description:** *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* (*M. tuberculosis*), transposon mutant 3171 was created by disruption of a possible succinate-semialdehyde dehydrogenase (MT1772, Rv1731) of the wild-type strain CDC1551. *M. tuberculosis*, strain CDC1551 is a clinical isolate that exhibited high levels of infectivity and virulence during a tuberculosis outbreak that occurred in rural Kentucky and Tennessee from 1994 to 1996.
