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Product Description:

Genomic DNA was isolated from a preparation of *Bacillus megaterium*, strain Ford 19 (Gibson 1060).

Bacillus megaterium is a Gram-positive, spore-forming aerobe. It is one of the largest and most common of the spore-bearing bacteria and has been found in dust, soil, milk, water, and as a lab contaminant.

NR-2543 has been qualified for PCR applications by amplification of ~ 735 bp of the 16S ribosomal RNA.

Material Provided:

Each vial contains 1–3 μ g of dried bacterial genomic DNA. The vial should be centrifuged prior to opening.

Packaging/Storage:

NR-2543 was packaged aseptically in screw-capped plastic cryovials. The product is provided frozen on dry ice and should be stored at -20°C or colder immediately upon arrival. Freeze-thaw cycles should be minimized.
