omments: Strain C309-64 has been typed as an enterohemorrhagic *E. coli* (EHEC) strain. 1-3 *E. coli*, strain C309-64 was selected to undergo complete genome sequencing at the J. Craig Venter Institute.

E. coli is a Gram-negative rod-shaped bacterium which occurs singly or in pairs. It is a major facultative inhabitant of the large intestine.

Many EHEC strains encode potent toxins, similar to those of Shigella dysenteriae, which can cause severe intestinal, kidney, and central nervous system disease.

Material Provided:

Each vial contains approximately 0.5 mL of bacterial culture in Tryptic Soy broth supplemented with 12.5% glycerol.

Note: If homogeneity is required for your intended use, please purify prior to initiating work.

Packaging/Storage:

NR-17650 was packaged aseptically in cryovials. product is provided frozen and should be stored at -60°C or colder immediately upon arrival. For long-term storage, the vapor phase of a liquid nitrogen freezer is recommended. Freeze-thaw cycles should be avoided.
