Product Description:

NR-19324 is a preparation of influenza B virus, B/Malaysia/2506/2004 that has been inactivated with beta-propiolactone (BPL). Influenza B/Malaysia/2506/2004-like viruses were recommended for use as part of trivalent influenza vaccines worldwide from 2006-2008. The source virus used for the inactivation was BEI Resources NR-9723. Complete inactivation was confirmed by three successive passages in embryonated chicken eggs.

Material Provided:

NR-19324 contains approximately 2.8×10^3 CEID₅₀ equivalents of BPL-inactivated influenza B virus, B/Malaysia/2506/2004 in 100 μ L of PBS.

Packaging/Storage:

NR-19324 was packaged aseptically in screw-capped plastic cryovials. Note that the sterility of the final product was not confirmed and is not guaranteed. The product is provided frozen and should be stored at -70°C or colder immediately upon arrival. For long-term storage, the vapor phase of a liquid nitrogen freezer is recommended. Freeze-thaw cycles should be avoided.
