Product Description:

Genomic DNA was isolated from a preparation of *Salmonella enterica* subsp. *enterica*, strain ATCC® 9150 $^{\text{TM}}$, serovar Paratyphi A.

Salmonella enterica (S. enterica) subsp. enterica serovar Paratyphi A has a narrow host range and causes paratyphoid fever in humans. It is similar to serovar Typhi, the cause of typhoid fever. The complete genome of Salmonella enterica subsp. enterica, strain ATCC[®] 9150[™] has been sequenced (GenBank: CP000026).¹

NR-4216 has been qualified for PCR applications by amplification of approximately 1500 bp of the 16S ribosomal RNA.

Material Provided:

Each vial contains 4–6 µg of bacterial genomic DNA in TE buffer (10 mM Tris-HCl and 1 mM EDTA, pH 7.4). The concentration is shown on the Certificate of Analysis. The vial should be centrifuged prior to opening.

Packaging/Storage:

NR-4216 was packaged aseptically in screw-capped plastic cryovials. The product is provided frozen on dry ice and should be stored at -20°C or colder immediately upon arrival. Freeze-thaw cycles should be minimized.
