Antibody Class: IgG2bk

Mouse monoclonal antibody prepared against the bradyzoite-specific protein P21 of *Toxoplasma gondii* clone T8 4G10 was purified from the hybridoma supernatant by protein G affinity chromatography. The B cell hybridoma was generated by the fusion of SP2/0 myeloma cells with immunized BALB/c mouse splenocytes. Clone T8 4G10 recognizes the P21 protein.¹ P21 (~ 21 kDa) is one of four bradyzoite-specific proteins that are expressed during tachyzoite-bradyzoite conversion.²

Material Provided:

Each vial contains approximately 100 μL of purified monoclonal antibody in PBS, pH 7.4. The concentration, expressed as mg per mL, is shown on the Certificate of Analysis.

Packaging/Storage:

NR-50273 was packaged aseptically in screw-capped plastic vials and is provided frozen on dry ice. The product should be stored at -20°C or colder immediately upon arrival. Freezethaw cycles should be avoided.

Functional Activity:

NR-50273 is functional in immunofluorescence and immunoblot assays.
