Titer:	Working dilution, 1:2000.
Description:	Routinely used for detection of proteins in bacterial extracts following induction of protein synthesis. The titer refers to what would be necessary to see p66 and p51 in a Western analysis with conventional colorimetric detection methods.
Special Characteristics:	Antigen is recombinant HIV-1 RT. The antibody is not directed against a specific epitope. No cross reactivity known.
Recommended Storage:	Keep at 4°C for short term storage and -80°C for long term storage. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles as reagent degradation may result.
