Buck, Director, Center for the Study of Biological Complexity, Department of Microbiology and Immunology, Virginia Commonwealth University Medical Center, Richmond, Virginia. The deposited material was inoculated into Lactobacilli MRS Broth and incubated for 24 hours at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere with 5% CO₂. The material from the initial growth was passaged once in Lactobacilli MRS Broth for 24 hours at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere with 5% CO₂ to produce this lot.
