Hillier, Department of Obstetrics, Gynecology and Reproductive Sciences, Magee-Womens Research Institute, University of Pittsburgh, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, USA. The deposited material was inoculated into Modified Reinforced Clostridial broth (ATCC medium 2107) and incubated for 72 hours at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere. The material from the initial growth was passaged once in Modified Chopped Meat Medium for 72 hours at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere to produce this lot.
