

The deposited material was inoculated into Modified Chopped Meat Medium (<u>ATCC medium 1490</u>) and incubated for 72 hours at 37°C and anaerobic atmosphere (80% N₂:10% CO₂:10% H₂). The material from the initial growth was passaged twice in Modified Chopped Meat Medium for 72 hours at 37°C and anaerobic atmosphere to produce this lot.
