

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²Erysipelotrichaceae sp., strain 6_1_45 was deposited by Professor Emma Allen-Vercoe, Department of Molecular and Cellular Biology, University of Guelph, Guelph, Ontario, Canada. The deposited material was inoculated into Modified Chopped Meat medium and incubated for 24 hours at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere (80% N₂:10% CO₂:10% H₂). Broth inoculum was added to kolles, which were incubated for 24 hours at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere to produce this lot.
