S. aureus, strain RN0450 is a non-pigmented, methicillin-sensitive S. aureus (MSSA) strain developed for research purposes.

¹S. aureus, strain RN0450 was deposited to BEI Resources as part of the NARSA collection. NR-45937 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Tryptic Soy broth and grown 24 hours at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere. Broth inoculum was added to Tryptic Soy agar with 5% defibrinated sheep blood kolles which were grown 24 hours at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere to produce this lot.

³4 hours at 37°C in rabbit serum with 0.15% EDTA (Coagulase Plasma BBL™ 240827)

⁵The production of beta-lactamase was detected using a Cefinase™ Paper Disc (BBL™ 231650).
