Fredricks, M.D., Principal Investigator, Vaccine and Infectious Diseases Division, Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center, Seattle, Washington, USA. HM-1241 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Modified Reinforced Clostridial broth and incubated for 2 days at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere (< 5% O₂; Remel™ Pack-Anaero™). The material from the initial growth was passaged once in Modified Reinforced Clostridial broth for 1 day at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere to produce this lot.
