Pseudomonas aeruginosa (P. aeruginosa), strain 1106432 was isolated in 2014 from the urine sample of a 70-year-old male in Kenya. It was deposited as resistant to amikacin, aztreonam, cefepime, ceftazidime, ciprofloxacin, doripenem, imipenem, levofloxacin, meropenem, piperacillin and tazobactam. NR-56656 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Tryptic Soy broth and grown for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere. The material from the initial growth was passaged in Tryptic Soy broth for 2 days at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere to produce this lot. Quality control testing was completed on Tryptic Soy agar under propagation conditions unless otherwise noted.
