Product Description:

Pseudomonas aeruginosa (P. aeruginosa), strain 1100156 was isolated in 2014 from a sputum sample of a 34-year-old female in Italy. It was deposited as resistant to amikacin, cefepime, ceftazidime, ceftazidime/avibactam, ciprofloxacin, doripenem, imipenem, levofloxacin, meropenem and piperacillin/tazobactam. NR-56654 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Tryptic Soy broth and grown for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere. Broth inoculum was added to Tryptic Soy agar kolles, which were grown for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere to produce this lot. Quality control testing was completed under propagation conditions unless otherwise noted.
