Aerococcus Ioyolae, Strain UMB0080

Product Description:

Aerococcus loyolae (A. loyolae), strain UMB0080 was isolated in 2013 from a urine sample via transurethral catheter of a patient with overactive bladder. A. loyolae, strain UMB0080 was deposited to BEI Resources as sensitive to vancomycin and the type strain for A. loyolae. NR-58628 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into NYC III broth and grown for 2 days at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere with 5% CO₂. Broth inoculum was added to Tryptic Soy with 5% defibrinated sheep blood agar kolles, which were grown for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere with 5% CO₂ to produce this lot.

<u>Note:</u> The species on the label is incorrect. NR-58628 was deposited to BEI Resources as the proposed species *Aerococcus loyalis* and was updated by the depositor to *Aerococcus loyalae* due to nomenclature rules.

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²Minimum Inhibitory Concentration (MIC). *A. loyolae*, strain UMB0080 was deposited as sensitive to vancomycin. No antibiotic resistance data for this antibiotic for *A. loyolae* is currently available.
