

Macrophage Cell Line Derived from MAL Knockout Mice

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Product Description: The murine macrophage cell line, NR-9459, was derived using primary bone marrow cells from MAL (MyD88 adaptor-like) knockout mice. The primary bone marrow cells were immortalized by infection with the ecotropic transforming replication-deficient retrovirus J2 using techniques described in the literature. Characterization based on immunofluorescence, stimulation assays and flow cytometry demonstrated that the immortalized cell line retains its macrophage-specific morphological, functional and surface expression properties.
