Product Description:

Genomic RNA was isolated from a preparation of pooled allantoic fluid from specific-pathogen free embryonated chicken eggs infected with influenza A virus, A/Aichi/2/1968 (H3N2).¹

Influenza A virus, A/Aichi/2/1968 (H3N2) was isolated in 1968 from a sailor on an Israeli ship docking at Aichi, Japan.

NR-9534 has been qualified for PCR applications by amplification of an approximately 1030 nucleotide sequence. Recommended dilutions for successful RT-PCR amplification are indicated on the Certificate of Analysis for each lot.

Material Provided:

Each vial contains 100 μ L of viral genomic RNA in TE buffer (10 mM Tris-HCl, 1 mM EDTA, pH 7.0). Lot 58007006 contains sodium azide; lot 62153957 does not. The viral genomic RNA is in a background of cellular nucleic acid and carrier RNA. The vial should be centrifuged prior to opening.

Packaging/Storage:

NR-9534 was packaged aseptically in screw-capped plastic cryovials. The product is provided frozen and should be stored at -60°C or colder immediately upon arrival. Note: The storage temperature indicated on the vial for Lot 58007006 is incorrect. Freeze-thaw cycles should be minimized.
