Product Description: The *Biomphalaria glabrata* embryonic (Bge) cell line was derived from embryos of the snail *Biomphalaria glabrata* by Eder Hansen in 1976. The original karyotype of this cell line was identical to that of the intact snail (n = 18), however, the Bge cell line now exhibits extensive aneuploidy. Bge cells are contact-inhibited upon reaching confluency.
