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²L. johnsonii, strain 135-1-CHN was deposited by Yang Liu, Ph.D., Senior Scientist & Group Leader, Osel Inc., Santa Clara, California. The deposited material was inoculated into Lactobacilli MRS Broth (BD 288130) and incubated for 48 hours at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere with 5% CO2. The initial growth was passaged once in Lactobacilli MRS Broth for 24 hours at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere with 5% CO2 to produce this
