Antibody Class: IgG<sub>1</sub>

Antibody Designation: IT-57 (CDA4)

Monoclonal antibody to *Mycobacterium tuberculosis*, strain H37Rv catalase-peroxidase (KatG) was produced in cell culture using a B cell hybridoma generated by the fusion of myeloma cells with immunized mouse splenocytes.

#### **Material Provided:**

Each vial contains approximately 500 μL of NR-13793 provided as cell culture supernatant.

# Packaging/Storage:

NR-13793 was packaged aseptically in screw-cap cryovials. The product is provided frozen on dry ice and should be stored at -80°C or colder immediately upon arrival. Freezethaw cycles should be avoided.
