

The deposited material was inoculated into Chopped Meat Carbohydrate Medium with 0.1% cellobiose, 0.1% maltose, 0.1% starch and 0.1% Tween 80 (ATCC medium 1102) and incubated for 5 days at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere. The material from the initial growth was passaged twice in Chopped Meat Carbohydrate Medium with 0.1% cellobiose, 0.1% maltose, 0.1% starch and 0.1% Tween 80 for 5-6 days at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere to produce this lot.
