Product Description:

Microbial mock community C is a microbial cell mixture of 22 different bacterial strains in phosphate buffered saline (PBS) and 40% glycerol.¹ The bacterial strains are listed in Table 1.

Note: The label for HM-281 is incorrect. HM-281 contains microbial mock community C and not microbial mock community A.

Each vial contains approximately 1 mL of bacterial culture in PBS and 40% glycerol.

Packaging/Storage:

HM-281 was packaged aseptically in screw-capped plastic cryovials. The product is provided frozen on ice and should be stored at -80°C or colder immediately upon arrival. Freeze-thaw cycles should be minimized.
