

²B. longum subsp. longum, strain 44B was deposited by Andrei Shkoporov, Senior Scientist, Department of Microbiology, Russian National Research Medical University, Moscow, Russia. HM-845 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Modified Reinforced Clostridial broth and incubated for 48 hours at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere (90% N₂:5% CO₂:5% H₂). The material from the initial growth was passaged once in Modified Reinforced Clostridial broth for 48 hours at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere to produce this lot. Purity of this lot was assessed for 7 days under propagation conditions.

³Colonies were occasionally observed when HM-845 was grown on Tryptic Soy agar with 5% defibrinated sheep blood for 48 hours in an aerobic atmosphere with 5% CO₂. *B. longum* subsp. *longum* is an aerotolerant anaerobe and the presence of growth in an aerobic atmosphere with 5% CO₂ is not unexpected.
