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²K. pneumoniae subsp. pneumoniae, strain WGLW2 was passaged three times and deposited by Wendy S. Garrett, M.D., Ph.D., Assistant Professor, and Leslie H. Wardwell, Department of Immunology and Infectious Diseases, Harvard School of Public Health, Boston, Massachusetts, USA. HM-751 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Nutrient broth and incubated for 24 hours at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere. Broth inoculum was added to kolles which were grown 24 hours at 37°C to produce this lot. Purity of this lot was assessed for 7 days under propagation conditions.
