Figure 2 – Stimulation of TNF-α

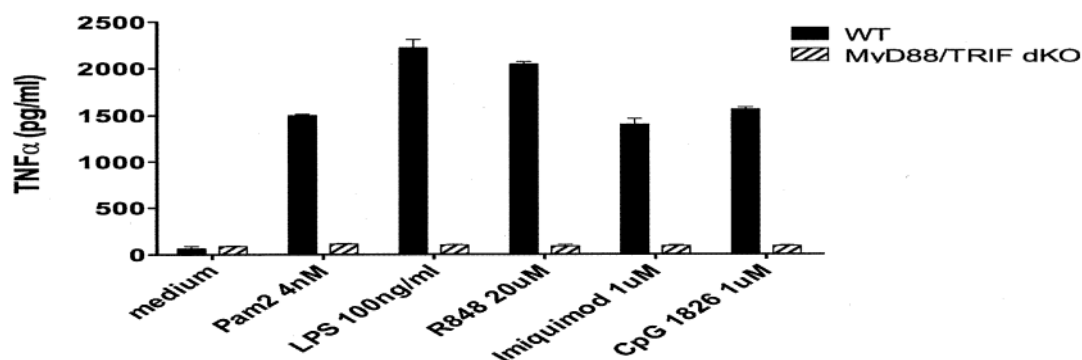


Figure 3 – Stimulation of RANTES
