Monoclonal antibody to *Mycobacterium leprae* phenolic glycolipid-1 (PGL-1) was produced in cell culture using a B cell hybridoma generated by the fusion of myeloma cells with immunized mouse splenocytes. The antiserum is reported to be active in ELISA.

**Material Provided:**

Each vial contains approximately 500 µL of NR-19370 provided as cell culture supernatant.

**Packaging/Storage:**

NR-19370 was packaged aseptically in cryovials. The product is provided frozen and should be stored at -80°C or colder immediately upon arrival. Freeze-thaw cycles should be avoided.
