NR-50747 is convalescent plasma collected on June 2, 2016 from a human subject who had recovered from infection with Zika virus. The sample was obtained approximately 52 days after the onset of symptoms.¹⁻³

Each vial contains approximately 0.1 mL of plasma.

Packaging/Storage:

NR-50747 was packaged aseptically in screw-capped plastic cryovials. The product is provided frozen on dry ice and should be stored at -20°C or colder immediately upon arrival. Freeze-thaw cycles should be avoided.
