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²HM-615 lot 70016913 was produced by inoculation of BEI Resources HMS-615 lot 60334570 into a LB soft agar overlay (0.7%) supplemented with 10 mM MgSO₄ containing the phage host, *B. pumilus*, strain 706S. The soft agar overlay was added to a LB agar kolle supplemented with 10 mM MgSO₄ and incubated 1 day at 30°C in an aerobic atmosphere. After two additional passages, the phage was harvested to produce this lot and is provided in LB broth supplemented with 10 mM MgSO₄ and 10% glycerol. The harvested material was stored at 4°C in an aerobic atmosphere for 22 days prior to cryopreservation.

³Lysis was observed after 1 day at 30°C in an aerobic atmosphere on a LB soft agar overlay supplemented with 10 mM MgSO₄ containing the phage host.
