

## H7 Hemagglutinin (HA) Protein from Influenza A Virus, A/Hong Kong/125/2017 (H7N9), Recombinant from Baculovirus

#### Product Description:

A recombinant form of the H7 hemagglutinin (HA) protein from influenza A virus, A/Hong Kong/125/2017 (H7N9)<sup>1</sup> was produced in Sf9 insect cells using a baculovirus expression system. The recombinant HA protein containing the H7 ectodomain and a six-histidine tag was purified by affinity chromatography.<sup>1</sup>

#### Material Provided:

Each vial contains 0.5 mL of purified recombinant HA protein in 50 mM Tris (pH 8) with 500 mM NaCl and 10% glycerol. The concentration, expressed as µg per mL, is shown on the Certificate of Analysis.

#### Packaging/Storage:

Purified recombinant HA protein was packaged aseptically, in screw-capped plastic cryovials. This product is provided on blue ice and should be stored at 2°C to 8°C immediately upon arrival.

#### Functional Activity:

NR-51367 is functional in SDS-PAGE, western blot, hemagglutination assay and ELISA.<sup>1</sup>
