Provided:	1 vial of lyophilized peptides.
	The 123 peptides from catalog #8117 peptide set were pooled together and then distributed such that each vial contains 50 μ g of each peptide, 6.15 mg total peptide.
Description:	A peptide pool comprising 123 individual peptides. Peptides are produced as 15mers with 11 aa overlap, spanning the HIV-1 Consensus B Gag protein.

Sequence:	See attached file below
	The HIV-1 Consensus B Gag reference sequence was obtained from the LANL HIV database (2002).
Purity:	Peptides are >80% pure. Detailed purity information is available in the attached file below.
Solubility:	Peptides that are difficult to solubilize can almost always be dissolved in DMSO. Once a peptide is in solution, the DMSO can be slowly diluted with aqueous medium. Care must be taken to ensure that the peptide does not begin to precipitate out of solution.
	Please note: Cys and Met containing peptide sequences are highly unstable when stored in DMSO for prolonged periods of time; peptide decay is often observed within days to weeks. If DMSO is required, we recommend freshly-prepared working solutions from freeze dried aliquots of these peptides, and prepared pools.
