Description: Poly (A)+ RNA was isolated from P. carinii trophozoites obtained from infected rats. This

material was used to construct a cDNA library, which was cloned into the unidirectional Uni-Zap XR I phage vector as EcoRI-XhoI fragments. The frequency of the DHFR gene in

this library is 0.013%.

P. carinii genomic DNA was partially digested with EcoRI, and the resulting 3-9 kb fragments were isolated by sucrose gradient fractionation and cloned into EcoRI

digested arms of the λZAPII vector.

Special Contains more than 90% recombinant bacteriophage with an insert range of 2.9-10 kb and an average insert size of 6 kb. The λ ZAPII vector allows expression of fusion **Characteristics:**

proteins under control of the lac promoter. Strand-specific RNA transcripts can be generated from the T3 and T7 promoters flanking the cloned sequences. Cloned fragments can be excised with helper phage and recircularized to generate subclones in

the pBluescript SK- phagemid vector.
