Special Characteristics:	Mice were immunized with a whole cell lysate of M. pneumoniae Eaton strain. Antibody 8A3.17 is specific for M. pneumoinae, and recognizes a 40 kD band in Western blots. The antibody does not cross react with other human mycoplasma species. Host Site: Balb/cAnNCr splenocyte × P3X63 Ag8.653 plasmacytoma. Titer: Use at 1:500 in Western blots. Isotype: Ig <sub>G3</sub> , k chain.
