Reacts well against a 27 kDa protein from EIA V-infected cell lysates in WB. Also reacts with gp46 in WB, but at a lower dilution (1:25). Does not work in cell immunostaining assays. |
| Recommended Storage: | Keep at 4°C for short term storage and -80°C for long term storage. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles as reagent degradation may result. |
