Clone: 0025 NR-58705 is a recombinant monoclonal mouse antibody, prepared against the monkeypox virus (MPXV) A29 protein (Sino Biological 40891-V08E), that was expressed from HEK293 cells and purified.¹

Material Provided:

Each vial of NR-58705 contains approximately 50 μ L of monoclonal antibody in phosphate buffered saline (PBS). The concentration, expressed as mg per mL, is shown on the Certificate of Analysis.

Packaging/Storage:

NR-58705 was packaged aseptically in screw-capped plastic vials and is provided frozen on dry ice. The product should be stored at -20°C to -80°C immediately upon arrival. NR-58705 can be stored at 2°C to 8°C for one month without detectable loss of activity. Freeze-thaw cycles should be avoided.

Functional Activity:

NR-58705 is specific to the MPXV A29 protein as shown in ELISA and western blot analysis (Figure 1), with minimal cross-reactivity in western blot with the A27L protein from vaccinia virus (strain Copenhagen) (Sino Biological 40897-V07E). No cross reactivity was observed in ELISA with A27L protein from vaccinia virus (strain Copenhagen) (Sino Biological 40897-V07E). ¹

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
