
Product Description: Salmonella enterica (S. enterica) subsp. enterica, strain LS1059 is a derivative of strain 14028 that expresses STM3119, tagged with 3 X FLAG epitopes. STM3119 is proposed to function as a monoamine oxidase (MaoA) that converts aminoacetone, which is the degradation product of L-threonine, to methylglyoxal.
