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²Prevotella sp., Oral Taxon 317, strain F0108 was deposited by Jacques Izard, Assistant Member of the Staff, Department of Molecular Genetics, The Forsyth Institute, Boston, Massachusetts. The deposited material was inoculated into Modified Chopped Meat Medium (<u>ATCC medium 1490</u>) and incubated for 48 hours at 37°C and anaerobic atmosphere (80% N₂:10% CO₂:10% H₂). The material from the initial growth was passaged once in Modified Chopped Meat Medium for 48 hours at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere to produce this lot.
