

The deposited material was inoculated into Modified Reinforced Clostridial Broth (ATCC medium 2107) and incubated for 48 hours at 37°C and anaerobic atmosphere (80% N₂:10% CO₂:10% H₂). The material from the initial growth was passaged once in Modified Reinforced Clostridial Broth for 48 hours at 37°C and anaerobic atmosphere to produce this lot.
