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**Source of Irradiated Antigen:** NR-37375, Lot No. 61152132

**Irradiation Protocol:** Infected cell pellets were resuspended in 50 mM sodium borate and 120 mM sodium chloride (pH 9) containing 1% Triton X-100, gamma-irradiated ( $5 \times 10^6$  RADs) on dry ice and sonicated. Cell debris was removed by centrifugation and the supernatant containing the irradiated antigen was aliquoted and vialled.
