

Comstock, Ph.D., Associate Microbiologist, Department of Medicine, Channing Laboratory, Brigham and Women's Hospital, Harvard Medical School, Boston, Massachusetts, USA. HM-734 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Modified Reinforced Clostridial broth and incubated for 4 days at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere (< 5% O<sub>2</sub>; Remel<sup>™</sup> Pack-Anaero<sup>™</sup>). Broth inoculum was added to Tryptic Soy agar with 5% defibrinated sheep blood kolles which were grown 3 days at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere to produce this lot.

<sup>3</sup>66 hours at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere on Tryptic Soy agar with 5% defibrinated sheep blood
