¹NR-31831 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Brain Heart Infusion broth. Broth inoculum was added to Chocolate agar and grown for 10 days at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere with 5% CO₂. A loopful of colonies from the Chocolate agar growth was suspended in Heart Infusion broth and used to inoculate Chocolate agar kolles, which were grown for 7 days at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere with 5% CO₂ to produce this lot.
