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²F. magna, strain GED7760A was deposited by Amanda Lewis, Ph.D., Assistant Professor, Department of Molecular Microbiology, Washington University School of Medicine, St. Louis, Missouri, USA. HM-1285 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Modified Chopped Meat broth and incubated for 3 days at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere (< 5% O₂; Remel™ Pack-Anaero™). Broth inoculum was added to Tryptic Soy agar with 5% defibrinated sheep blood kolles, which were grown for 3 day at 37°C in an anaerobic atmosphere to produce this lot.
