Product Description: The murine macrophage cell line, NR-9568, was derived using primary bone marrow cells from TRIF (toll-interleukin-1 receptor-domain-containing-adaptor-inducing interferon-β)/TRAM (TRIF-related adaptor molecule) knockout mice. The primary bone marrow cells were immortalized by infection with the ecotropic transforming replication-deficient retrovirus J2 using techniques described in the literature.
