### **Product Description:**

Acinetobacter baumannii (A. baumannii), strain 1081925 was isolated in 2014 from the blood sample of a 46-year-old female in Greece. It was deposited as resistant to amikacin, cefepime, ceftazidime, ceftriaxone, ciprofloxacin, doripenem, imipenem, levofloxacin, meropenem, piperacillin/tazobactam and tetracycline. NR-56557 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Tryptic Soy broth and grown for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere. The material from the initial growth was passaged in Tryptic Soy broth for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere to produce this lot. Quality control testing was completed under propagation conditions unless otherwise noted.
