

**Acinetobacter baumannii, Strain 1089072**

**Product Description:**

*Acinetobacter baumannii* (*A. baumannii*), strain 1089072 was isolated in 2014 from the ulcer sample of a 33-year-old male in Greece. It was deposited as resistant to amikacin, cefepime, ceftazidime, ceftriaxone, ciprofloxacin, colistin, doripenem, imipenem, levofloxacin, meropenem, piperacillin/tazobactam and tetracycline. NR-56559 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Tryptic Soy broth and grown for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere. The material from the initial growth was passaged in Tryptic Soy broth for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere to produce this lot. Quality control testing was completed under propagation conditions unless otherwise noted.
