Note: The label on the vial is incorrect; the plasmid expresses eGFP.

HRP-13908 is a single-cycle vector encoding full-length HIV-1_{ZM249M} [primary, transmitted/founder HIV-1 clone (clade C) derived from single genome sequencing] in the plasmid pUC57-mini with deletion of 79 nucleotides following the Env signal peptide and eGFP in place of *nef*. The beta-lactamase gene, *bla*, provides transformant selection through ampicillin resistance in *Escherichia coli* (*E. coli*). The deposited plasmid was transformed into One Shot™ TOP10 *E. coli* (Invitrogen™ C404003), grown in Luria-Bertani broth with ampicillin (50 µg/mL) for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere, extracted using a Plasmid Plus Maxi Kit (QIAGEN® 12963) and vialled in TE buffer (10 mM Tris-HCl, 1 mM EDTA, pH 8.0).
