Citrobacter freundii (*C. freundii*), strain 1049882, was isolated in 2013 from a bronchoalveolar lavage sample of a 44year-old male in Russia. It was deposited as resistant to aztreonam, cefepime, ceftazidime, ceftriaxone, ciprofloxacin, levofloxacin and piperacillin/tazobactam. NR-56585 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Tryptic Soy broth and grown for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere. The material from the initial growth was passaged in Tryptic Soy broth for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere to produce this lot. Quality control testing was completed under propagation conditions unless otherwise noted.
