## **Product Description:**

Neisseria gonorrhoeae (N. gonorrhoeae), strain 1137292 was isolated in 2014 from a urethral sample of a 37-year-old male in Israel. It was deposited as resistant to ciprofloxacin and tetracycline. NR-56643 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Chocolate broth and grown for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere with 5% CO<sub>2</sub>. The material from the initial growth was passaged in Chocolate broth for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere with 5% CO<sub>2</sub> to produce this lot. Quality control testing was completed under propagation conditions unless otherwise noted.
