Klebsiella pneumoniae (K. pneumoniae), strain 868968 was isolated in 2012 from a urine sample of a 65-year-old male in Belgium. It was deposited as resistant to aztreonam, cefepime, ceftazidime, ceftriaxone, ciprofloxacin, colistin, colistin/P80, doripenem, imipenem, levofloxacin, meropenem and piperacillin/tazobactam. NR-56624 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Tryptic Soy broth and grown for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere. Broth inoculum was added to Tryptic Soy agar kolles, which were grown for 1 day at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere to produce this lot. Quality control testing was completed under propagation conditions unless otherwise noted.
